

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD SEPTEMBER 13, 1982

President Shealer called the September meeting to order at 7:30 PM with the following members present: Mrs. Daniels, Mrs. Romero and the Messrs. Heflin, Ditzler, Witt, Miller, Cluck and Madsen.

The minutes of the August meeting were approved as read.

Attorney Wolf appeared, on behalf of GMA, to present a resolution that will enable the Gettysburg Municipal Authority to issue participation notes to raise funds to purchase a CATSCANNER for use by the Gettysburg, Hanover, Waynesboro and Chambersburg Hospitals.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Cluck Council approve the Resolution to permit the sale of tax-free participation notes by the Gettysburg Municipal Authority for purchase of a Computerized Axial Tomography Scanner. The Borough will not be financially obligated in any manner. Motion carried.

James Nett, announced the Gbg Fire Dept. is planning a mini-carnival October 9 & 10, proceeds to go to Retail Merchants Fund Drive to replace Christmas decorations lost in fire. He asked Council to close Liberty Street from York Street to East Middle those two days. The Carnival Committee will meet with Police Chief and Mayor rel to parking regulations during carnival.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Liberty Street be closed as requested for the mini-carnival on October 9 & 10. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Witt seconded Mr. Heflin the public hearing for the proposed amendment to the Zoning Ordinance be held October 11, 1982 - 7 PM. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Miller seconded Mr. Cluck Patrolman Sheppard and Grissom be retained on a permanent status as recommended by Chief Potter and Mayor Weikert. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler parking be removed from the southeast quadrant of Lincoln Square November 6 and 7 as requested by Adams County Historical Society for use of State Mobile Museum. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Madsen all approved bills (\$162,074.59) and payrolls be paid. Motion carried.

Safety Committee after conferring with Police Chief, Mayor and Messrs Sterner and Lawver mad the following recommendations:

1. Remove parking from west side of South Washington Street from the old entrance to hospital south to Johns Avenue
2. Remove parking from west side of South Washington Street from Johns Avenue south for 46 feet
3. Removed parking from S. Washington Street -west side- 40 ft north of Kuhn Alley
4. Parking on Gettys Street to remain as is
5. 2 way traffic be retained in Kuhn Alley

These recommendations tabled until next month.

Mr. Witt reported on the discussion of the Community Relations Committee rel to weeds/grass growing through cracks in the sidewalks.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Cluck Walter D. Fohl, Jr. be appointed to fill vacancy on Gettysburg Area Industrial Development Authority. Mr. Fohl's term to expire July '83. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Daniels seconded Mr. Cluck letters of commendation be sent to president of each participating team in the various leagues using Rec Park facilities. Motion carried.

Mrs. Romero reported Dave Johnson has resigned from Rec Board. Two other vacancies will be filled in the near future.

Moved Mr. Cluck seconded Mr. Witt the Fire Company be permitted to display equipment in observance of FIRE PREVENTION WEEK on southwest quadrant of Lincoln Square on October 4, 1982 from 6 PM to 9 PM. Motion carried.

Mr. Heflin - Highway Committee Chairman reported

1. Paving of Ridge Avenue completed
2. List of sidewalks and curbs for repair/replacement in '83 will be presented next month
3. Borough Officials had met with Mr. Kuntz re drainage problems east end of York Street

Mr. Sterner's report

1. In suit of Borough vs Retreat Judge's decision in favor of Borough
2. Atty. Oyler has sent a letter to Chessie Officials - still negotiating rel to storm sewer under tracks
3. Sweeper has been sent to Harrisburg for repair
4. Committees should begin working on next year's budget

President Shealer announced Realtor Watch Program will hold a meeting at Holiday Inn on September 16th at 9 Am. Atty. Oyler and Mr. Witt to attend from Borough.

A letter of thanks for help received during July carnival was read from James Nett.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Cluck the reports of the Mayor, Police Chief, Treasurer and Code Enforcement Officer be approved. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler the Fire Marshall's report be accepted. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Cluck the sign proposals of Rebert's TV and Ribbons and Bows be approved as HARB recommended and certificates of appropriateness issued. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Cluck seconded Mr. Madsen the renovation proposals of Winebrenner Estate for 143 Chambersburg Street and 449-451 Baltimore Street be approved as recommended by HARB and certificates of appropriateness issued. Motion carried.


Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Cluck the HARB Minutes be accepted. Motion carried.

Mr. Heflin reported a number of abandoned tanks are buried throughout the town. Property owners urged to remove them.
