

MINUTES OF MEETING HELD NOVEMBER 8, 1982

President Shealer called the November meeting of Council to order at 7:30 PM. The following Council members were present: Mrs. Daniels, Mrs. Romero, and the Messers. Cluck, Miller, Heflin, Ditzler, Witt and Madsen.

The minutes of the October Council meeting and the public hearings held October 11 and November 1 were approved as read.

Ted Sutphen and Ivan Bollinger were present to protest removal of parking on Steinwehr Avenue and South Washington Street as per proposed amendment to parking ordinance. Mr. Sutphen presented petition bearing 27 signatures.

Mayor Weikert reported receiving a resolution from Ken Cole that was issued by the State Legislature commemorating Penna's 300th anniversary.

The Mayor reported several members of the police force had attended special training sessions during the past month.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Council adopt the amendment to the parking ordinance (removal of parking - Steinwehr Avenue and S. Washington Street) as advertised. Motion defeated - 2 ayes Ditzler and Heflin; 5 nays Daniels, Madsen, Witt, Romero, Cluck.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin all approved bills (\$66,397.24 and payrolls be paid. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Council tentatively adopt the 1983 budget in the amount of \$1,000,452. Motion carried.

Mr. Witt reported the National Park has announced some of Eisenhower's books from Eisenhower College have been taken to the Farm and placed on display there.

Mr. Madsen reported receiving a request for an additional street light on Howard Avenue near Buford. Utility Committee to consider.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Madsen Council appoint Cathy Rhoads to Rec Board to replace Sue Davis whose term expired. Ms. Rhoads's term to expire in 1987. Motion carried.

Moved Mrs. Romero seconded Mrs. Daniels a street light be erected on Barlow Street between Stratton and Pine Streets. Motion carried.

On recommendation of Safety Committee stop signs will be erected in Race Horse Alley at the Franklin Street intersection.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Witt sidewalk and curb notices be sent for properties needing repair or replacement. Motion carried.

Mr. Sterner reported receipt of letter from Chessie waiving the \$750 fee originally requested for storm sewer work on West Railroad Street. \$100 cost of preparation of Agreement to be paid by the Borough.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Ditzler the treasurer be authorized to transfer \$21,558.64 from the General Fund to Fireman's Relief Fund. Motion carried.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Cluck Council proclaim the week of November 7 thru 13 as Disabled Veterans Week in the Borough. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Heflin 3 copies of the Pennsylvanian be ordered for 1983. Motion carried.



FOR ADDITIONAL STREET LIGHTING

WHEREAS, a contract was entered into between the Borough of Gettysburg, County of Adams and Metropolitan Edison Company on 9-28-73 (date) whereby Company shall furnish lighting; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and proper that additional lighting should be installed and maintained for the service, accommodation, convenience and safety of the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Gettysburg, pursuant to the provisions and terms of the Company's applicable Rate Schedules and Riders, and the rules and regulations now on file and such rules and regulations, Rate Schedules and Riders hereafter filed from time to time and in effect with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Tariff), does hereby order and direct Metropolitan Edison Company to furnish additional lighting consisting of

Install 1-7100 Lumen Mercury Vapor Lamp on Pole ME 775 GB Located on Barlow Street at Hazel Alley Between Pine and North Stratton Streets
