

Council Meeting December 9, 1985

President Shealer presided at the December meeting of Council. The following Councilmembers attended: Messrs. Figgel, Hartzell, Schmitt, Linn, Mrs. Daniels, Messrs. Madsen, Witt, Ditzler.

The Minutes of the November meeting were approved as prepared.

Larry Fetter representing DMI requesting Council to consider rebuilding North Sixth Street, north of York Street, Highway Committee directed to study and if approved could possibly be included in 1986 Highway Aid Budget.

Cliff Germano expressed his concerns for future solid waste disposal. Was told the Council was holding a meeting that night that Mayor Weflin was attending instead of being at the Council Meeting.

Approximately 20 persons attended rel to Special HARB Meeting held November 12, 1985.

Moved Mr. Schmitt seconded Mrs. Daniels Council approve the HARB recommendation and deny the certificate of appropriateness for the White Mountain Creamery proposal. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Linn the proposal to paint exterior trim and replace damaged shutters at 30 Baltimore Street be approved as HARB recommended and a certificate of appropriateness issued. Motion carried by majority vote - Mrs. Daniels dissenting.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Madsen Gary Yount's proposal for color Change of exterior trim at 9 - 11 Chambersburg Street be approved as HARB recommended. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Madsen Council approve the Minutes of the Special Meeting held November 12, 1985 and of the Regular meeting held November 27, 1985. Motion carried.

Mr. Ditzler reported as a result of recent State Supreme Court ruling the use of Speed-chek devices has been declared illegal.

Motion Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Hartzell letters be sent to Rep. Cole and Sen. Moore in opposition to this ruling and solicit their support in having legislation enacted to sustain a proven system of speed control. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Witt all approved bills and payrolls be paid. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Hartzell Council adopt the 1986 Budget, amount \$1,180,242.00; tax rates to remain unchanged - real estate 25 mills, occupation 25 mills, per capita \$5.00. Motion carried by majority vote, Mrs. Daniels dissenting.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Ditzler Council approve the list of recipients for Eichelberger-Stahle Charity Funds. \$676.00 was distributed among 17 families. Motion carried.

Mrs. Daniels reported Sidewalk and Tree Committee had studied 92 properties - of that number 47 will be sent notices to have repairs made prior to August 1, 1986.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Schmitt the 47 properties be notified to have sidewalk/curb repairs completed by August 1, 1986. If work is not done by that date Borough will do the work and bill the property owner. Motion carried.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Schmitt the seven wheelchair ramps be installed on Lincoln Square as soon as possible, approximate cost \$300.00 each. Motion carried.

Mrs. Daniels reported she will continue searching for an architectural manual for HARB use.

Mr. Fiscel reported Kiwanis Club is planning to repair the pavilion at Rec Park; also MacDonalds have given 18 benches to Rec. Park.

Mr. Schmitt went on record commending Mrs. Daniels for the fine service she has given the borough and council during the past four years, especially the tree planting project.

Mr. Schmitt reported receipt of a complaint rel to Sheetz Bros. accumulating trash, etc. at rear of the property. Mr. Lawver to investigate.

Mrs. Daniels presented the Ordinance Committee with a list of changes she would recommend for HARB procedures.

Moved Mr. Witt seconded Mrs. Daniels the '82 police car be advertised for sale to highest bidder. Motion carried.

Manager's report

1. Council to consider publication of a newsletter.
2. Commuter shuttle schedules by Gettysburg Tours to be changed.
3. John Earnst reported Federal Govt. will probably provide the traffic signal, Steinwehr Avenue, if the Borough will pay the installation costs.
4. Mr. Van Arsdale from College to meet rel to moving Constitution Ave.
5. 1984 Small Communities Grant, amount \$96,000 received - \$93,000 forwarded for Fahnestock Building project.

6. Wall Alley - remove parking on Baltimore Street for visibility or make travel one-way, etc. Safety Committee to study.

7. Expressed displeasure with Getysburg Times rel to recent editorials.

Mr. Lawver reported the Fahnestock project progressing very nicely.

President Shealer reported:

1. The sidewalk on Princess Street has been placed.

2. Commended Mrs. Daniels for 4 years of dedicated service to the Borough.

3. Bicentennial Committee in need of additional funds, will be given \$200 now and if needed more after the first of the year.

4 Bicentennial Committee seeking a commemorative stamp.

President Shealer, Mayor Heflin and Mr. Linn to write Postal Service in support of the project.

Correspondence read: A letter from DGI requesting permission to hold Home/Life Mart on Lincoln Square May 10 and May 11. Parking to be removed. A letter was also received from Borough Planning Commission rel to rezoning a portion of Steinwehr Ave.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Madsen Council accept the reports of the Mayor, Police Chief, Treasurer, Code Enforcement Officer, and Fire Dept. Motion carried.

Next meeting will be held January 6, 1986, 7:30 P.M. - organization meeting.

Moved and seconded meeting adjourn at 9:00 P. M. Motion carried.
