- 2. Mr. Stokes prepared an application for additional funds from the **
 *** Revers. Mixkoxkoxk Commixsxkox. Application approved for \$1,000.
 - 3. Mr. Wright has prepared application to submit for third year funding of Main Street Program. Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Hartzell the application for 3rd year funding be submitted. Motion carried.
 - 4. Was not necessary to borrow funds in anticipation of taxes.
 - 5. The Final Revenue Sharing Fund check, in the amount of \$1,611.00 has been received and a public hearing for its use must be held.
 - 6. An Accounting Package for office computer has been ordered as per budget.
 - 7. Mr. Wilbur Plank, owner of a plot of land rear of Carlisle Street and south of Delap Avenue, has offered to lease the area for a public parking lot. The Parking Lot Committee to investigate possibilities.
 - 8. National Park Tour route includes the intersection on Steinwehr Avenue with South Washington Street and Taneytown Road. NPS has offered the placement of a traffic signal at the location, if the Borough would pay for the installation and future maintenance. Mr. Sterner directed to negotiate further with Park Service.
 - 9. Mr. Wright is presently working toward replacement of trash receptacles in the Borough.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Witt the proposal for Barbara/Sue Venture for placement of a doorway be approved as HARB recommended and issue a certificate of appropriateness. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Heflin Council approve HARB Minutes. Motion carried.

Mr. Stokes reported HG-AC have indicated they will be giving \$2500 toward Borough's match of Penna. Museum & Historical Commission Grant for fiscal year 1987.
