COUNCIL MEETING MAY 14, 1990

President Stokes called the meeting to order at 7:30 P.M. with all of Council present. Also present was Mayor Linn, Mr. Oyler, Mr. Sterner, Mr. Lawver, Mr. Weikert, Chief Gantz, Mr. Little, and Mr. Powell.

Those citizens in attendance include:
Pete Swinn, 29 Lincoln Avenue, and Wm. Troxell, East Broadway,
who urged quick action on the Residential Parking Permit system.

Bill Ridinger and Jim Codori from Company "K" requested a monument to be placed in the Bender Quadrant. Council felt that the monument would be more appropriate at the Court House. Would like to have a meeting with the Commissioners to discuss how they feel about the placement of the monument.

Steve Wiley, Hoffman Road, Littlestown requested a mural to be painted on the water tower behind the Holiday Inn. Noted that it would take approximately 8 months to complete and the cost would be \$90,000. Mr. Songer, Mr. DeHaas, Mr. Frazee, Mrs. Simpson, Mrs. Daniels, and Mr. Schmitt all agreed this would not be appropriate. Mr. Witt, and Mr. Ditzler had no comment.

Mayor Linn presented a citation presented to the Borough from the U.S. Army for supporting national defense.

Mayor Linn requested a flag be placed on the square for the POWMIA.

Moved Mr. Songer, seconded Mr. DeHaas to display the POWMIA flag on Veterans Day and the week of Memorial Day. Motion Carried.

Moved Mr. Songer, seconded Mr. Schmitt to pay all bills and payrolls. Motion Carried.

Mr. Schmitt requested that some of the work for the deck such as the rest room job be kept in Adams County.

Mr. Sterner reported the progress on the deck is going very well. He spoke to the contractor and they cannot lower the rate for the rest rooms. Instructed Poole to install the rough-in plumbing only. We will contract the work out to bidders at the completion of the deck.

Mr. Sterner reported that Merle Simpson is very happy with the progress. He visited the precast company and was very pleased with that work also.

Mr. DeHaas reported that the Utility Committee will meet on May 22nd at 2:30 pm. and asked that the committee members attend.

Mrs. Daniels reported that the Health Committee will meet on May 22nd at 4:00 pm. and the Tree Committee will meet the last week in May.

Mrs. Daniels stated that she needs Rec Board and Code Enforcement Appeals Board nominees and requested the assistance of Council in locating interested persons. Mr. Frazee reported the College would like two changes to be made on the Parking Ordinance. Bill Walker, Jay Brown, and Tim Linn, speaking on behalf of the college requested the following changes:

- 1. Proposed No Parking from Water St. to Lincoln Ave.
- 2. Move Meters to the South side of Stevens Street.

Moved Mr. Frazee, seconded Mr. Songer to adopt the Parking Meter Ordinance including the changes as requested from Gettysburg College. Motion Carried.

Mr. Witt requested that citizens who voice complaints should be kept anonymous. Council agreed to this policy.

Moved Mrs. Simpson, seconded Mr. Schmitt to submit the CDBG application to DCA in the amount of \$98,005 for housing projects on Breckenridge and S. Washington Streets. Motion Carried.

Mr. Stokes commended Walt Powell on his presentation to DCA in Harrisburg on May 11th.

Mr. Sterner reported:

- Met with Drew Sontag, Chief Gantz, and Penn Dot Officials, to finalize plans for work on the square.
- Need to advertise bids for the Lincoln Square project so they can be opened at the June 11th meeting.
- Reported Penn Dot will be paving Route 30 in 1991.

Moved Mr. Schmitt, seconded Mrs. Simpson to advertise Bids for the Lincoln Square Project. Motion Carried.

Moved Mr. Frazee, seconded Mr. DeHaas to approve \$4,204.20 County Aid application to be applied to paving jobs. Motion carried.

Mr. Lawver Reported:

- 1. Spring clean up is over. Crews hauled 30 loads of brush, 8 loads of metal, 13,850 pounds of refuse.
- Traffic light inspection revealed problems with poles at York St. and Fourth St. which will need to be replaced.
- 3. Constitution Avenue will be closed from May 29th to the 1st week of July for bridge construction.
- 4. Approximately 30 Rotarians were at the Rec Park for community service.

Mr. Weikert reported that 144 Hauling Permits were sold. Considered the permit method for spring clean-up very successful.

Mr. Little reported meter enforcement will begin to use the new parking tickets on Friday May 18th.

Moved Mrs. Daniels, seconded Mr. Frazee to approve HARB "consent agenda". Motion Carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler, seconded Mr. Schmitt to approve all reports. Motion Carried.

Moved Mr. Schmitt, seconded Mr. Ditzler to approve the Tax Exonerations. Motion Carried.

Moved and seconded to adjourn at 10:15 PM.
