Mr. Kreisher, Public Works Committee, reported that the sidewalks were inspected in the west end with about 50 notices sent out. The Committee also received preliminary information from the engineer, Andy Brough, concerning the flooding along Ridge Avenue. He reported that additional field surveys will be needed to better determine a solution. The committee authorized the work, with a report due at the next committee meeting on November 21.
