Following the election Mayor Lightner turned the meeting over to President Shealer. Both President Shealer and Mr. Heflin expressed their thanks for confidence of Council in electing them to their respective offices.

Moved Mr. Rebert seconded Mr. Ditzler Hazel A. Dillman be appointed Borough Secretary at a salary of \$6,000.00. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Rebert Charles E. Kuhn be appointed Borough Treasurer and Borough Manager at a salary of \$15,000.00. Mr. Kuhn to post \$40,000. bond with the Borough to pay the premium. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Rebert Donald G. Oyler be retained as Borough Solicitor at the same fee. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler the Gettysburg National Bank be named depository for General Funds and The Adams County National Bank be named trustee for Police Pension Funds. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler Nelson J. Groft be appointed Code Enforcement Officer, Assistant Borough Manager and Assistant Borough Treasurer at a salary of \$13.990.00. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler that Clarence H. Cluck be retained as Chief of Police at a salary of \$13,550.00. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler the salary schedule as presented by the Wage and Salary Board be approved retroactive to January 1, 1978. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Rebert the regular meetings of Council be held the second Monday of each month at 8 P.M. Same to be advertised in local newspaper. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Rebert seconded Mr. Heflin Council officially adopt the 1978 budget and set the tax millage at 15 mills. Motion carried.

Spectators included Mrs Gerald D. Shealer and former Council President Weikert. Mr. Weikert congratulated the new President and Vice President on their election and the other officials on their re-appointment.

Mayor Lightner in his remarks to Council ask members to cooperate and support the President and Vice President.

Moved Mr. Rebert seconded Mr. Ditzler all approved payrolls and bills be paid including a \$12.64 bill for commission presented by Jeanne S. Harner with final settlement of 1977 taxes. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Rebert seconded Mr. Delzingaro the Borough Treasurer on the arrival of the Eichelberger-Stahle Funds interest check deposit same in a Golden Pass Book account until needed in December. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Rebert seconded Mr. Ditzler the Treasurer be authorized to pay utilities with blanket approval to avoid paying additional costs if held until the next meeting. Motion carried.

Safety Committee to study possibility of increasing the fines for illegal parking. Overtime parking fines to remain the same.

Finance Committee to study and recommend whether or not the Borough should claim to f the 1% earned income tax currently being collected by the School District, also to f the 1% property transfer tax now being collected by the School District.

Utility Committee to study and consider increasing candlepower at some cross walk areas throughout the town.

Health Committee to survey town and approach owners of properties where trash, old lumber, etc. have accumulated to clean up and avoid rat infestation.

Mr. Groft directed to contact owners rel to traffic exiting ento West Middle Street from private parking lot. When permit was given it stipulated "ENTRANCE ONLY" from West Middle Street.

Mr. Kuhn recommended 6" or 8" sewer pipe be used for short distances. Sewer Committee to study and make recommendation.

Mr. Heflin reported that to date no word has been received concerning the status of the new police car. Pet Milk Corporation has not yet responded to the Borough's proposal re Franklin Street but local representatives are optimistic of its acceptance.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Rebert all oil companies making deliveries within the Borough be sent a letter and a copy of the ordinance requiring them to block the wheels. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Rudisill seconded Mr. Rebert that Robert M. Smith be re-appointed to serve a five year term on the Borough Planning and Zoning Commission, Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Rebert seconded Mr. Delzingaro that Council accept the resignation of Harold R. Alden as Third Ward Assessor. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Delzingaro seconded Mr. Heflin that Mrs. Yvonne Wieder, 655 Highland Avenue, be recommended for appointment as the assessor for the Third Ward. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Rebert seconded Mr. Heflin the tax collector, Mrs. Harner, be exonerated of \$145.00 per capita, \$41.25 occupation taxes and liens placed for \$3,539.07 unpaid real estate taxes. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Delzingaro the reports of the Mayor, Treasurer, and Police Department be accepted. Motion carried.

A discussion rel to towing vehicles from private property was held with the suggestion that letters be sent to Senator Moore and Rep. Cole protesting this bill.

Moved and seconded meeting adjourn at 10 P.M. Motion carried.






