### MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JANUARY 8, 1979

President Shealer called the January meeting to order at 8 P.M. with all Councilin attendance.

The minutes were approved as read.

Mrs. Dorothy Craver, on behalf of Y.W.C.A., inquired concerning a committee from Council to work on the proposed building site. President Shealer informed her the Property Committee of Council, the Property Committee of the Recreation Board and Mr. Oyler had been designated to meet with the "Y" Committee and their solicitor.

Andrew Parker, Gettysburg College Student, serving an internship ("J" term) with Chamber of Commerce attended to observe proceedings.

Paul Witt inquired as to Council's ability to enact legislation that would require the Utility Companies to place the overhead wires underground as a preliminary step toward the Steinwehr Avenue Beautification Project. During the discussion several Councilmen expressed the opinion that if the Beautification Committee can provide funds to cover the expense the Utility Companies would probably cooperate.

Barry Noel presented Fire Company reports and was informed Council would welcome a recommendation from the Gettysburg Fire Department for the position of Borough Fire Marshall since Mr. Kuhn has requested to be relieved of the position. Mr. Groft will centinue to serve in that capacity until a successor is appointed.

Tom Metz and John Strickler presented a sign proposal for Gettysburg Battle Theatre and Cafeteria. The proposal will have to be revised to conform to the ordinance.

Moved Mr. Delzingaro seconded Mr. Lawver all approved bills and payrolls be paid. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Delzingaro seconded Mr. Rudisill the Frank Ruth CPA Firm be engaged to do the 1978 and 1979 annual audit. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Delzingaro seconded Mr. Heflin the salary of the Mayor be increased to \$2,400.00 per annum, retroactive to January 1, 1979. Motion carried.

Mr. Reimer reported/the December meeting of CAA Board that he attended on December 21, 1978.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Delzingaro Council adopt the ordinance, amending the parking meter ordinance, removing Saturday evening hours for meter operation. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Delzingaro the ordinance authorizing the erection of a stop sign on King Street at its intersection with Sunset Avenue be adopted. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Delsingaro the ordinance prohibiting truck traffic in Patrick Alley be adopted. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Ditzler Council adopt the ordinance making a portion of Patrick Alley one-way. Motion carried.

Mr. Miller reported the additional lights have been erected in Wolf Alley and Race Horse Alley.

Mr. Heflin reported the bridge near DeSimons has been inspected and will be repaired in the Spring.

#### Minutes of January 8, 1979 (cont'd)

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Swope the Borough adopt the Planning Module of Bonanza Sirloin Pit as an approved addition to the Borough's Official Sewage Plan in accordance with Chapter 71, Administration of Sewage Facilities Program, Title 25 Penna. Code. Motion carried.

Mr. Heflin inquired as to who is responsible for removal of snow frm sidewalks along municipal parking lots. Council determined the property owner must clean the sidewalk-sidewalk-the Borough removes snow from parking area only.

Mr. Lawver reported the Adams County Quick Call does not have an official routing for emergency vehicles after a Snow Emergency has been declared. A letter listing the official Snow Emergency Route to be prepared and a copy given to the Quick Call, Adams County Ambulance Association and Borough Police.

Moved Mr. Swope seconded Mr. Ditzler that approximately 600 ft of storm sewer be placed on North Fourth Street from East Lincoln Avenue south to the Tiber to eliminate ice problems. Motion carried.

Property Committee directed to consider preparation of spacs for purchase of a Police Car.

Moved Mr. Delzingaro seconded Mr. Rudisill Council authorize EADS to revamp last year's HUD Grant application and submit same for consideration in the distribution of 1979 funds at a cost of \$500.00 Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Council adopt the resolution rel to the distribution of receipts derived from the proposed levy of an additional 3 per gallon gasoline tax, should this measure be enacted by the State Legislature. Motion carried. (Resolution placed in Minute Book)

Mr. Groft announced the Penna. Historical Museum Commission had contacted him rel to having the Minute Books from 1806 to an undetermined cut-off date microfilmed at no cost to the Borough. Should it become necessary due to loss by fire or theft the tapes will be available at a cost of \$15.00 per roll. Council approved and Mr. Groft to arrange to have work done.

Mayor Lightner reported he has been questioned on numbeous occasions re holes around trees on Lincoln Square caused by laying the brick segments. Mr. Groft to contact to Committee in charge to have holes filled with ground.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Heflin the 1979 Municipal Yearbook be order from PSAB. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Delzingaro seconded Mr. Lawver the bill of \$44.00 for Legislative Newsletter be paid. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Swope the Borough Tax Collector be exonerated of \$211.25 occupation and per capita taxes to enable her to apply for bond for 1979. Motion carried. (List placed in Minute book).

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Council approve the Treasurer's report, the yearly report of Sgt. Potter and the December and annual reports of the Mayor and Police Chief. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Lawver seconded Mr. Delzingaro the sign proposal of H and H Pontiac Inc. be approved as recommended by HARB and a certificate oa ppropriateness issued. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Lawver seconded Mr. Delzingaro the recommendation of HARB be approved and a certificate of appropriateness issued. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler the recommendation of HARB be approved and a certificiate of appropriateness is sued for sign proposal of Beneficial Finance. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconfed Mr. Heflin the renovation proposal for James Smith property be apprived as presented by H.B. & H. Contractors and recommended for approval by H.A.R.B. A certificate of appropriateness to be issued. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Lawver seconded Mr. Heflin the minutes of the December meeting and annual report of HARB be accepted. Motion carried.



#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, local highway expenditures are expected to rise from \$363 million in 1975 to \$470 million in 1980, but State highway aid to municipalities is only expected to increase from \$83.4 million in 1975 to \$93.7 million in 1980; and

WHEREAS, local highway expenditures are financed through local tax revenues primarily from property taxes, and are increasing at an annual rate of 11%, and municipalities are now spending the equivalent of 10.6 mills in taxes on property for local roads and streets; and

WHEREAS, State highway aid to municipalities from the liquid fuels tax is expected to drop from 18.7% in 1975 to 16.6% of total local highway expenditures by 1980; and

WHEREAS, the State highway system is completely financed through highway user revenues (gasoline taxes), but municipalities must tax property and use other local tax sources to finance construction and maintenance of the 65,000 miles of local roads in Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Department of Transportation estimates it is in need of an additional \$200 million annually to adequately finance the State highway system, and has called for an additional 3 gasoline tax be enacted by the Pennsylvania Legislature; and

WHEREAS, municipalities have historically received 20% of the State collected, locally shared liquid fuels taxes;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough of Gettysburg urges the Pennsylvania General Assembly to earmark 20% of any proposed gasoline tax increase to municipalities, to help offset the rising costs of local highway construction and maintenance and keep the real property tax from rising; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that copies of the resolution be sent to the Governor, Senator and House members and to the State Association.
