## MINUTES OF MEETING HELD JULY 12, 1982

President Shealer called the meeting to order with the following members of Council present: Ditzler, Witt, Madsen, Daniels, Romero, Cluck, Miller and Heflin.

The minutes of the June meeting were approved as read.

Gerald White, president of Gettysburg Teener League, discussed a recent letter he had received from Raymond Thompson rel to dragging and lining playing fields. Council advised him to attend the Rec Board meeting and discuss the problem with the Rec Board.

Mayor Weikert's report-

- 1. Ptlm Hershel Shank has been accepted at Police Academy. Session to begin August 30th and run thru November 19th.
- 2. Recommended Council consider removing parking on both sides of Gettys Street from South Washington Street west to Fairview Avenue.
- 3. Consider removal of parking on west side of South Washington Street from old hospital entrance south to Johns Avenue.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Cluck an ordinance regulating yard sales and requiring a permit to hold same be advertised for August adoption. Motion carried.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Heflin Council adopt the Comprehensive Plan. Motion carried. (Copy of Resolution placed in Minute Book following these Minutes).

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Heflin J. Glenn Guise be appointed to serve a 5 yr term on the Gettysburg Area Industrial Development Authority. Motion carried.

Moved Mrs. Daneils seconded Mr. Heflin a resolution of commendation be sent to Mary Alice Nutter, chairman of Adams County Youth Career Aid Project. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Cluck Council approve the budget of Adams County Earned Income Tax Collection Agency. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Witt the eld police car ('79 Chevrolet) be donated to the Fire Department. Motion carried by majority vote. 3 ayes-Madsen, Witt, Romero; 1 nay-Miller; 4 abstentions-Cluck, Heflin, Daniels, Ditzler.

Mr. Witt reported HG-AC has been working with U. S. Postal Authorities for a commemorative stamp that will go on sale November 19th.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin all approved bills (\$85,579.05) and payrolls be paid. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Madsen Council accept the recommendation of G. H. Harris Associates and exonerate the names listed on Report #3 except Nos. 1, 4, 12. These three will be resubmitted for further attempts to collect. Motion carried.

Mr. Heflin reported work will begin on Lefever Street next week to be followed by West Street the following week.

Mr. Heflin urged Council members to inspect their respective wards and submit list of properties that need curb and sidewalk repair or replacement.

Mr. Miller reported Safety Committee still working on Mutual-aid Agreement with National Park Service.

Moved Mr. Miller seconded Mr. Heflin Ptlm Hershel Shank attend Police Academy for manadatory training, from August 30th thru November 19th. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Miller seconded Mr. Cluck cost estimates for two C-B radios be obtained for presentation at August Council meeting. Motion carried.

Mrs. Romero reported vandalism at Rec Park still a major problem.

Mr. Cluck reported Ordinance Committee is working on drafting an ordinance rel to control of establishing or operating head shops, massage parlors, etc.

President Shealer directed Safety Committee to study the Mayor's recommendations rel to removal of parking on Gettys Street and west side of a portion of South Washington Street.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Madsen Council accept the reports of the Mayor, Police Chief, Treasurer and Code Enforcement Officer. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Council approve the recommendation of HARB for the sign proposal of "Noteworthy Music" and issue a certificate of appropriateness. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Council approve the proposal of Adams County Commissioners to erect a Commemorative Marker as HARB recommended and issue a certificate of appropriateness. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Witt the plans of First Hanover Corp. for new bank building and their sign proposal be approved as HARB recommended and a certificates of appropriateness issued. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Madsen the minutes of HARB be accepted. Motion carried.

Moved and seconded meeting adjourn at 9:15 PM. Motion carried.
