COUNCIL MINUTES FEBRUARY 13, 1989

President Stokes presided at the meeting called to order at 7:30 P. M. with all Council members present.

The January Minutes were approved as presented.

The Agenda, for the evening was approved as amended.

President Stokes congratulated Acting Chief Gantz on his recent graduation and receipt of his Master Degree.

All the social clubs sent representatives to Council to seek Council's favorable consideration of placing on the May Primary ballot the question of issuing a license, enabling the clubs to operate small games of chance.

Motion Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler Council adopt the Resolution requesting the County Board of Election to place the following question on the May Primary ballot: "Do you favor the issuance of licenses to conduct small games of chance in the Borough of Gettysburg". Motion carried unanimously.

Mayor Linn reported he had sworn Larry Weikert in as a part-time police officer.

The Mayor also reported receiving an application and check from Waste Management of York to obtain a garbage license. The Mayor and several others plan to go to York, to witness their operation and inspect their equipment, within the next few days.

Mrs. Daniels, Council's rep to Gettysburg Municipal Authority, announced the offices are being moved to their new facilities at the sewer plant. On March 16th at 3 P.M. members of Council will tour the new facilities.

Mrs. Daniels reported due to changes by the legislature a member of the Borough Planning and Zoning Commission can no longer serve as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board. Andrew Larson to be replaced on the Zoning Hearing Board as Mr. Larson has chosen to remain on the Boro. Planning and Zoning Commission.

Motion Mrs. Daniels second Mr. Schmitt that a resolution of acknowledgement and gratitude for his dedication and years of service on the Zoning Hearing Board be prepared and presented to Mr. Larson. Motion carried.

Moved Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Songer Council appoint Leonard E. Andrews, 100 West Broadway, to fill the unexpired term of Andy Larson on the Zoning Hearing Board. Term to expire December 1990. Motion carried.

Mrs. Daniels discussed the possibility of expanding the Zoning Hearing Board to five members. Reason being to receive additional input into discussions of applications also assure a quorum at the meetings. Planning and Zoning Commission to be requested to consider this proposal and report next month.

Moved Mrs. Daniels second Mr. Frazee Council appoint Janet Hikes, 460 Knight Road, as a representative to the South Central Community Action Agency Board. Motion carried.

Mrs. Daniels reported that during the January Property Committee meeting the options for new Borough facilities were discussed. Several architects have been approached to prepare cost estimates for said options.

Mrs. Daniels displayed a copy of Historic Survey Committee findings.

Motion Mrs. Daniels seconded Mr. Schmitt the application for the 4th year CLG grant, amount \$15,000, be prepared and submitted. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Schmitt seconded Mrs. Simpson the list of unpaid 1988 real estate taxes be filed with the Tax Claim Bureau and the unpaid per capita and occupation taxes to be forward to the delinquent collector. Motion carried.

The 1988 Audit is complete. Council to study until next meeting.

Mr. Schmitt reported the Personnel Manual nearing completion. A meeting of the Personnel Committe scheduled for February 21 at 3 P.M.

Mr. Ditzler made a motion that Mr. Heflin seconded to have the yellow line section of the ordinance on parking amended to extend the yellow line an additional 20 ft at the southeast corner of the West Middle-West Street intersection to permit use of the mailbox by motorists. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Witt seconded Mrs. Simpson the ordinance to make a portion of Springs Avenue a "Snow Emergency Route" be approved. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Witt seconded Mr. Frazee Council approve the ordinance to change the 15 minute meters on East High Street to 2 hour meters. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Witt seconded Mr. Heflin a stop sign be erected at the intersection of Warner Alley and West High Street and the ordinance authorizing this be adopted. Motion carried.

Mr. Frazee reported a Parking Lot meeting will be held March 1st at 10 AM.

Manager's report:

- 1. Borrowed \$100,000 until tax revenues are received.
- 2. Will be attending seminars on tax reform
- 3. County Planning Commission advised the Borough that the Borough needs their own Sub-division ordinance. Mr. Detwiler will be asked to review and advise Council on the County plan.
- 4. Recommended Council buy an annuity from non-uniform pension funds for Ray Baker, effective March 1, 1989, cost \$47,399.39

Moved Mr. Frazee seconded Mr. Schmitt the manager be authorized to purchase an annuity for Ray Baker's pension. Motion carried.

President Stokes appointed Mr. Frazee chairman of the bargaining committee for up-coming police negotiations. Other members of the Committee are Mr. Heflin and Mr. Songer.

Moved Mrs. Simpson seconded Mr. Ditzler the reports of the Mayor, Treasurer, Police Chief and Code Enforcement Officer be approved as presented. Motion carried.

With no further business a motion and second were received for adjournment at 9:15 PM. Motion carried.
