RESOLUTION APPOINTING DEPOSITORY AND FIXING SECURITY

BE IT RESOLVED, that The Adams County National Bank, of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, be and hereby is appointed as a depository for Borough funds, collateral security consisting of bonds of the United States or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any political subdivision thereof, to be deposited by such depository with the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia of a market value of one hundred twenty per centum of the amount of the deposit to be secured, such deposit of collateral to be under proper agreement and to be accompanied by proper assignment or power of attorney for the transfer of said bonds, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to require such depository to furnish collateral security to cover the amount of any deposit to the extent that the same is insured with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

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

RESOLUTION APPOINTING DEPOSITORY AND FIXING SECURITY

BE IT RESOLVED, that The Gettysburg National Bank, of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, be and hereby is appointed as a depository for Borough funds, collateral security consisting of bonds of the United States or the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or any political subdivision thereof, to be deposited by such depository with the Federal Reserve Bank of Philadelphia of a market value of one hundred twenty per centum of the amount of the deposit to be secured, such deposit of collateral to be under proper agreement and to be accompanied by proper assignment or power of attorney for the transfer of said bonds, provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall be construed to require such depository to furnish collateral security to cover the amount of any deposit to the extent that the same is insured with the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation.

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
