

PUBLIC HEARING - FEBRUARY 6, 1985

The public hearing to receive comments from the public sector rel to use of Community Block Grant Funds was called to order by President Shealer at 3:30 PM.

Those attending included all council members, except Mr. Witt, Attorney Oyler, Mayor Heflin, Chief Potter, Mr. Sterner, Tom Jolin, Frank Sapp, Andrew Larson and Mike Sanders, Times Reporter.

Purpose of meeting - to receive citizen input for proposed use of Community Block Grant, in the amount of \$138,285.00.

Mr. Sapp, Downtown Gettysburg, Inc., read a statement that requested \$12,000 be allocated to conduct traffic and parking study.

Mr. Sterner presented proposal of Russel Arkin Associates for \$82,500 for the Fahnestock Building and \$42,000 for Recreation Park Restrooms.

With no further comments the hearing adjourned at 3:45 PM.
