COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
FEBUARY 11, 2019

President Susan Naugle called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM with the following Councilors present: Vice President Jacob Schindel, Mr. Wesley Heyser, Ms. Patricia Lawson, Mr. Christopher Berger, Mr. John Lawver and Mr. Charles Strauss. President Susan Naugle announced that the purposes of the public hearing are to inform and to obtain public comment prior to taking any formal action relative to the adoption of the proposed Central Adams Joint Comprehensive Plan.

Solicitor Eastman gave a brief explanation of the Central Adams Joint Comprehensive Plan process. He said that it is mandated by the PA Planning Code, and that Borough Council must conduct a public hearing before adopting the plan.

Public Comments

Mike Shestok, 264 Baltimore Street, urged Council not to use the plan to promote the Gettysburg Municipal Authority and York Water Company, stating the “Big Pipe” is not necessary.
