PUBLIC HEARING AUGUST 8, 1988

Purpose - to receive citizen input for 1988 SCP Competitive Funds.

Mary Alice Nutter read the following: "The Third Ward Housing Committee requests the Borough of Gettysburg approve \$350,000 of non-entitlement monies for the augmentation of funds set aside for the Breckenridge Street Housing Project that has previously been approved by the Borough. We are requesting that \$6,000 of the monies be targeted for an engineering study of the Ice House area including the buildings in front located on Washington Street."

Jean Odom endorsed the above proposal and stated while the first priority was the 3rd Ward the committee hopes to expand the project beyond the 3rd Ward to eliminate blight in the Borough. Presently 20 - 30 houses are targeted for renovations.

President Stokes extended Council's appreciation to Mary Alice, Jean and Mr. Sterner for the long hours spent on these projects.

With no further comments forthcoming a motion by Mr. Heflin with second by Mr. Ditzler the hearing be adjourned at 7:15 P. M. was received. Motion carried.
