PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES JANUARY 14, 1991 7:00 P.M.

President Stokes called the meeting to order with all of Council present. Also in attendance was Mayor Linn, Chief Gantz and Dr. Powell.

Dr. Powell explained the proposed budget Amendment of the 1990 Budget for Community Development Block Grant Funds. In addition to meeting eligibility requirements, each activity must also meet three National Objectives of the CDBG Program: 1.) Benefit low to moderate income persons or families; 2.) Remove slums or blight; 3.) Meet an urgent need (emergency). The following Budget Amendment is proposed:

CDBG Fiscal Year 1990

- 1. Move \$15,500 from "Housing Rehabilitation" to "Acquisition/Relocation," for use to enable Adams County Interfaith Housing Corporation to complete the purchase of 53 Breckenridge Street in Gettysburg. This building will be subsequently rehabilitated and sold to an eligible homeowner through the "Homeownership Program." The Amended Budget for 1990 will then be as follows:
 - A. "Housing Rehabilitation--Adams County Interfaith Housing Corporation": \$14,364.10
 - B. "Housing Rehabilitation--Pennsylvania Housing and Economic Development Corporation": \$40,000
 - C. "Acqusition/Relocation--Adams County Interfaith Housing Corporation": \$26,000

With no public comment the meeting adjourned at 7:20 P.M.
