## PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES MAY 13, 1996

President Simpson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm with the following Councilors present: William Troxell, Margaret Gustafson, Jay Schmitt Sr., Richard Kreisher, Charles Woodward and Leonard Andrews. Also in attendance were: Mayor Linn, Manager Sterner, Grants Manager Powell, Highway Superintendent Lawver, Main Street Representatives Andrew Larson, John Murphy and Dawn Williams-Heflin, Darlene Brown, representing the Housing Authority, Steve Niebler representing the Office for Aging, Lisa Mathers, The Pub and Joe Patti, 136 N Stratton Street.

Dr. Powell gave a brief summary of the two proposals to sponsor grant applications to the Pennsylvania Department of Community Affairs for "Housing and Redevelopment Assistance Funds" for 1996-97. The proposals are as follows:

- An application on behalf of South Central Community Action Programs, Inc. for approximately \$300,000 to provide acquisitionrehabilitation funds for a Homeownership Program in the Borough. Kucharski representing SCCAP gave a presentation on the program.
- An application on behalf of Main Street-Gettysburg, Inc. for approximately \$150,000 to complete the enhancement of the Wills House quadrant of Lincoln Square, and to replace existing street lights and provide street furniture in the first blocks of Baltimore, Chambersburg, Carlisle and York Street.

With no further discussion the hearing was adjourned at 7:25 pm.
