**COUNCIL PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES (CDBG)**  
**AUGUST 27, 2018**

President Susan Naugle called the meeting to order at 6:45 PM with the following Councilors present: Mr. Charles Strauss, Mr. Wesley Heyser, Mr. Christopher Berger and Mr. John Lawver. Vice President Jacob Schindel and Ms. Patricia Lawson were absent. Staff present included: Mayor Theodore Streeter; Borough Manager Charles Gable; Borough Secretary Sara Stull; Borough Solicitor Harold Eastman; Planning Director Becky LaBarre; Finance Director Nickie James; Parking Manager Richard Miller; Interim Public Works Director Robert Harbaugh; and Chad Clabaugh, Borough Engineer, C. S. Davidson, Inc.

Others present include: Deb Adamik, President, Main Street Gettysburg; Rebecca Moreland Grants Program Coordinator, Adams County Office of Planning & Development; Mike Shestok, 264 Baltimore Street; and Becka Fissel, Borough Parking Enforcement Officer. Representing the press was Jim Hale with the *Gettysburg Times*.

President Susan Naugle announced the public hearing is for the purpose of receiving public comment on the proposed use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds.

Manager Gable reported it is estimated that approximately \$123,298.00 of grant funding will be made available to benefit the Borough of Gettysburg for its use in fiscal year 2019. He noted that two public hearings are required to receive public comment on the proposed use of CDBG funds. Manager Gable said that the Borough has been using the funding for Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) curb ramps throughout the Borough.

Borough Engineer Chad Clabaugh said that the Borough has construction projects that are also eligible for CDBG funding.

**Public Comment:**

**Mike Shestok, 264 Baltimore Street** commended Council and staff for using the CDBG funding to do the ADA curb ramps.

President Susan Naugle adjourned the public hearing at 6:55 PM.
