He announced that this is the second public hearing as required to give citizens an opportunity to make their comments known regarding what types of eligible activities Gettysburg Borough should apply for under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) programs.

Planning Director Carly Marshall announced that the Borough of Gettysburg will receive an allocation of \$129,141 in FY2023 CDBG funds from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. She said that the Borough is proposing to repair curb cuts for compliance with the American Disability Act (ADA) along various alleys throughout town (see attached list). The Borough would use the full allocation for the curb cuts and not use any of the funds for administration. If Council approves to proceed then an application would be submitted through Adams County Office of Planning and Development who manages the CDBG program.
