

PUBLIC HEARING - PROPOSED USE REVENUE SHARING
January 27, 1981

The first of two required public hearings on proposed use of 1981 Revenue Sharing Funds was called to order at 7:30 PM by President Shealer. Those attending included, Messrs. Heflin, Cluck, Delzingaro, Ditzler, Swope, Witt, Mayor Lightner, Charles Sterner, John D. Lawver, Jr., Barry Hallett, Roy Thomas and Mike Sanders from WGET.

Barry Hallett representing Gettysburg Fire Company reported the department would appreciate any additional financial assistance Council could see fit to give them.

Roy Thomas, speaking as a tax payer, reported he was sorry that more people hadn't attended. He inquired about the Police Department budget and whether Council planned to increase the number of policemen. He also reported he would like to see Council adopt a mercantile tax.

Mr. Sterner explained the proposed use of the funds and read a letter the Borough had received from the Office of the Aging.
