

SECOND PUBLIC HEARING - REVENUE SHARING FUNDS - NOV. 9, 1981

President Shealer opened hearing at 7 PM with the following councilmen present: Messrs. Heflin, Miller, Cluck, Reimer, Ditzler, Madsen and Swope. Also attending: Mrs. Elizabeth Daniels, Raymond Thompson and Edward McManness from Recreation Department and Mike Sanders, WGET.

The minutes of the first hearing were approved as read.

Mr. Sterner presented Revenue Sharing Fund Budget for 1982.

A letter was read from Gettysburg Civic Chorus requesting they be included in 1982 budget.

Moved Mr. Madsen seconded Mr. Miller \$300 be removed from Police Salary allocation and earmarked for Gettysburg Civic Chorus. Motion carried.

Hearing adjourned at 7:10 P.M.

The November Council meeting was called to order by President Shealer at 7:30 P.M. with the following Councilmen in attendance: Messrs. Heflin, Miller, Cluck, Reimer, Ditzler, Madsen and Swope. Mr. Wolf attended in Mr. Oyler's absence.

The minutes were approved as read.

George Lambert expressed concern rel to hazards created by bicyclists that are riding at night without lights.

Mr. Swope reported trees on Square will be pruned during the winter, sprayed next spring and possibly top soil will be added at that time.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin all approved bills (\$45,578.24) and payrolls be paid. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin Council tentatively adopt the 1982 budget in the amount of \$970,376.00. Motion carried.

Mr. Reimer reported the Ordinance Committee recommended Mr. Olinger's request re-zoning of his property be turned over to the Planning Committee for study.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Heflin the following Resolution be adopted: "Resolved that no transcript of the testimony given before the Gettysburg Borough Zoning Hearing Board shall be prepared at the expense of the Borough of Gettysburg except in the case of an Appeal to Court from a Decision of the Board". Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Ditzler the ordinance amending Subsection 2 of Section 1701 of the Zoning Ordinance be advertised for adoption at December meeting. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Heflin the ordinance forbidding public use of the Rec Park at stated times be advertised for adoption. Motion carried.

Mr. Miller reported the police contract has been signed; the Safety Committee recommend a Civil Service Exam be scheduled; the Safety Committee recommended Wade Avenue remain as is.

Mr. Heflin reported leaf collection in progress; the 1982 Highway-aid Budget will be presented next month; the catch basin on York Street has been repaired by Penn Dot.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Swope the Treasurer be authorized to transfer \$19,357.40 from the Borough General Fund to Gettysburg Fire Company Relief Fund. Motion carried.

Mr. Lawver reported HARB Brochures are ready for distribution.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Ditzler the exoneration of Janice L. Holmes for 1980 taxes be approved as requested by G. H. Harris Associates. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Reimer seconded Mr. Cluck Council approve a 2 year ('82 & '83) contract with Penn Valley Publishers for annual codification of ordinances. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Madsen the reports of the Mayor, Treasurer, Chief of Police, Code Enforcement Officer and Fire Department be accepted. Motion carried.

Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Cluck Council accept HARB Minutes and the Fire Marshall's report. Motion carried.

Moved and seconded meeting adjourn at 8:30 P.M. Motion carried.
