

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES
APRIL 12, 1999

President Eline called the hearing to order at 7:00 PM with the following Councilors present: Mrs. Gustafson, Mr. Woodward, Mr. Wiley, Mr. Kreisher, Mr. Andrews, Mr. Murphy and Mayor Troxell. Staff included Manager Sterner, Code Enforcement Officer Weikert, Robert Reilly of the Evening Sun and Josh Dooley of the Gettysburg Times. No citizens attended the meeting.

Mr. Weikert gave a brief presentation on the proposed Subdivision and Land Development Ordinance.

Mr. Woodward is concerned about the location of dumpsters in apartment developments. The ordinance states 3 of 4 sides to be screened by walls or evergreen landscaping from view of existing dwellings.

Mr. Weikert noted the ordinance should read 3 or 4 sides to be screened. The correction will be made to the original.

Mr. Weikert noted that the application fee for subdivision and land development review and approval is \$100.

With no further business, President Eline closed the hearing at 7:15 PM.
