

PUBLIC HEARING

JULY 9, 1990

President Harry Stokes called the hearing to order at 7:00 PM with all of Council present except Mrs. Jean Simpson and Mr. Charles Songer. Also present was Mayor Linn, Mr. Charles Sterner, Mr. John Lawver, and Chief Gantz.

Dr. Walter Powell gave a presentation to Council on the need to amend the 1987 and 1989 Community Development Block Grant Budgets in order to proceed with the projects currently proposed. He submitted the following proposed budget amendment:

CDBG Fiscal Year 1987

1. Acquisition/Relocation--move \$50,045 to this activity from the previous "Housing Rehabilitation" to reflect the actual use of the money (to be applied toward the purchase of 55 Breckenridge Street and 268 South Washington Street).
2. Handicap Access/Removal of Architectural Barriers--Adams County Library (Old Post Office Building) --\$33,362.

CDBG Fiscal Year 1989

1. Acquisition/Relocation--\$48,436.80 (to be used in assisting in the purchase of 55 Breckenridge Street and 268 South Washington Street, and in relocation expenses anticipated)
2. Handicap Access/Removal of Barriers--Adams County Public Library (Old Post Office)--\$32,291.20

Citizens in attendance to discuss the reallocation included:

Carol M. Davenport, Executive Director of the YWCA requested a donation for the Senior Citizens Program which runs September thru May. The Borough allocated \$8300 last year for this program and they requested the same for this year. Mrs. Davenport handed out copies of the budget and program for further review.

Hazel Lawver, a senior citizen who attended the program at the YWCA spoke on the merits of the YWCA program.

Mr. Powell reported that the 1985 Budget needs reallocated and that possibly at that time a donation could be made to the YWCA for the Senior Citizens Program. A Public Hearing will be scheduled for August concerning the 1985 Budget.
