The meeting was called to order promptly at 7:00 P.M. by President Shealer. Present at the meeting were the following Councilmen: Messrs. Ditzler, Heflin, Swope, Delzingaro, Reimer and Lawver.

The purpose of this Special Meeting was to award bids which had been tabled at the regular Council meeting for further study.

In reviewing the bids for corrugated steel pipe, Mr. Groft disclosed that he had contacted the Materials Division of Penn Dot relative to the bid of Chemung Supply Corporation, Elmira, N. Y. and was informed that while the pipe manufacturer was accepteable the supplier is not on Penn Dot's approved bidder's list. Moved Mr. Heflin seconded Mr. Swope that the next lowest bidder, the American Tank and Culvert Company, an approved supplier, be awarded the bid. Motion passed unanimously.

Moved Mr. Ditzler seconded Mr. Heflin that the bid of Don Warner's Chevrolet-Buick, Inc. be accepted with the trade-in of a 1977 Pontiac LeMans for a 1979 Chevrolet Police Vehicle at a cost of \$5,819.51. Motion passed unanimously.

With no further business, moved and seconded meeting adjourn at 8:00 P.M. Motion carried.
