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A motion to authorize the enactment of an ordinance for the general purpose of granting tax exemption relief for certain new construction and improvements to designated deteriorated properties within the Borough pursuant to the Local Economic Revitalization Tax Assistance Act ("LERTA"), and for the specific purposes of setting a maximum tax exemption amount, adopting the following ten-year tax exemption schedule for a minimum of fifty (50%) percent non-residential use and a minimum of twenty-five (25%) percent residential use for such development or redevelopment with construction costs of improvements exceeding one million (\$1,000,000.00) dollars: for years 1 and 2 a 100% tax exemption; for years 3 and 4 a 90% tax exemption; for years 5 and 6 an 80% tax exemption; for years 7 and 8 a 70% tax exemption; for years 9 and 10 a 60% tax exemption; and setting forth a procedure for securing a tax exemption and providing for a rollback of taxes exempted due to a subsequent change of use.
