A motion to authorize entry into and to ratify a new Collective Bargaining Agreement between the Borough of Gettysburg and the Teamsters Local Union No. 776 on behalf of the Non-Uniformed employees of the

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Gettysburg Borough for the contract term and period of five (5) years from January 1, 2018 through December 31, 2022. Robert L. Krummerich, President of Borough Council, and Sara L. Stull, Borough Secretary, are hereby authorized to execute, attest and deliver the Collective Bargaining Agreement on behalf of the Borough of Gettysburg.
