A motion to adopt a resolution authorizing Gettysburg Municipal Authority to assist Gettysburg College in a plan of financing for its project including the advance refunding of outstanding 2010 revenue bonds and financing of certain capital additions and improvements to the facilities of Gettysburg College and authorizing the Authority's issuance of revenue bonds in 2017 to finance the costs of the project with no liability whatsoever, financially or otherwise, on the part of the Borough of Gettysburg in adopting this resolution.
