#### **Notice of Public Hearing**

The Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg shall hold a public hearing on Monday, June 24, 2019, commencing at 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers at the Gettysburg Borough Municipal Building located at 59 East High Street, Gettysburg, PA 17325.

The purpose of the public hearing is for the Borough Council to receive information and to obtain public comment prior to taking any formal action regarding the enactment of a proposed amendment to the Gettysburg Borough Zoning Ordinance which, if enacted, would amend the Official Zoning Map of Gettysburg Borough. The proposed zoning map amendment, if enacted, would reclassify and rezone, from the Institutional-1 (INS-1) District to the adjacent Residential Office (RO) District, a parcel of real property located along the eastern side of Schoolhouse Alley and along the southern side of Wall Alley at the intersection of the two alleys, a portion of a second parcel of real property located on the eastern side of Schoolhouse Alley, and a third parcel of real property designated as Lot 2 on a recorded subdivision plan located along the southern side of Wall Alley. The draft Ordinance containing the proposed zoning map amendment may be examined without charge or obtained for a charge not greater than the cost thereof at the Office of the Borough of Gettysburg from the Borough Secretary during regular business hours (Monday through Friday, 8:00 A.M. - 5:00 P.M.). In addition, the draft Ordinance containing the proposed zoning map amendment may be downloaded from the Gettysburg Borough website at www.gettysburgpa.gov.
