Discussion of Police Cadet compensation package

A motion to approve a specified Police Cadet Compensation and Provisions employee summary for purposes of enabling the Borough's hiring and employment of police cadets for attendance at the Police Academy in order to qualify for and receive Act 120 certification as a police officer.
