A motion made pursuant to the authority provided in the Borough Code, as codified at 8 Pa. C.S. § 1190(d), for the Borough to furlough the paid employee and full-time police officer of the Gettysburg Borough Police Department who was last appointed to the Borough's police force in order to reduce the number of paid employees of the police force for reasons of economy due to the financial impact of an arbitration award. This action returns the police force from nine paid officers to 8 paid officers as adopted by the Borough Council for the 2020 Budget. This action is taken subject to the statutory reinstatement requirements of the furloughed police officer as set forth in the Borough Code at 8 Pa. C.S. § 1190(d).
