

RESOLUTION NO. 010917-1

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 903(a) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, the governing body of a municipality is authorized to appoint, by resolution, residents of the municipality as members to its zoning hearing board; and

WHEREAS, on March 9, 2015, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg appointed Roger Goodacre, a resident of the Borough of Gettysburg, as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board of the Borough of Gettysburg to fill the vacancy in such office created by the resignation of Mark E. Weaver and to serve for the remainder of the unexpired term of office of Mr. Weaver as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board, which term expired on December 31, 2016; and


WHEREAS, due to the expiration of the term of office of Roger Goodacre as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board of the Borough of Gettysburg, the Borough Council desires to appoint a resident of the Borough of Gettysburg as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board for a five (5) year term commencing in January 2017 and expiring on the first Monday in January 2022.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg does hereby appoint Roger Goodacre, a resident of the Borough of Gettysburg, as a member of the Zoning Hearing Board of the Borough of Gettysburg for a five (5) year term commencing in January 2017 and expiring on the first Monday in January 2022.

This action is taken under and pursuant to the power and authority of the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg to appoint residents of the Borough of Gettysburg to serve as members of the Zoning Hearing Board of the Borough of Gettysburg as found in section 903(a) of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.
