

**RESOLUTION NO. 030810-4**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg has adopted, enacted and ordained its Code Enforcement Appeals Board Ordinance on March 8, 2010; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 7. of the aforesaid Ordinance, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg shall prescribe reasonable fees with respect to hearings conducted before the Code Enforcement Appeals Board. Such fees may include compensation for the Borough appointed secretary, notice and advertising costs, the appearance fee for a stenographer, and any necessary administrative overhead costs connected with the hearing; and


**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg desires to adopt a resolution establishing the fee for hearings before the Code Enforcement Appeals Board.

**WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg does hereby adopt the following fee for all hearings before the Code Enforcement Appeals Board:


1. The fee for a hearing before the Code Enforcement Appeals Board shall be Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
2. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
3. The provisions of this Resolution may be amended according to law by a resolution duly adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg and approved by the Mayor of the Borough of Gettysburg.


