

RESOLUTION NO. 91007-2

WHEREAS, the Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Gettysburg has been created pursuant to the provisions of the Borough Code; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the provisions of the Borough Code at 53 P.S. § 46176, a civil service commission shall have the power to prescribe, amend and enforce rules and regulations governing its operation and procedures relative to civil service employees; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the provisions of the Borough Code at 53 P.S. § 46176, before any such rules and regulations may be in force and effect, they must be approved by the Borough Council; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held on August 14, 2007, the Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Gettysburg amended its rules and regulations and adopted the same; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the requirements of the Borough Code, the Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Gettysburg submitted the adopted rules and regulations to the Borough Council for approval; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg desires to approve the Rules and Regulations for the Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Gettysburg, which were adopted by the Civil Service Commission at its August 14, 2007 meeting.


WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg hereby approves the Rules and Regulations for the Civil Service Commission of the Borough of Gettysburg as adopted on August 14, 2007 which Rules and Regulations are attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

FURTHER RESOLVED, that Theodore H. Streeter, President of Borough Council, and Sara L. Stull, Borough Secretary, shall execute the rules and regulations to indicate the approval of the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg.


This action is taken under and pursuant to the power of the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg to approve rules and regulations adopted by the civil service commission as found in the Borough Code at 53 P.S. § 46176.
