

**RESOLUTION NO. 12808-2**

**WHEREAS**, on June 12, 2000, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg enacted and ordained Ordinance No. 1240-00, its Recycling Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 8, 2008, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg enacted and ordained Ordinance No. 1355-08, amending its Recycling Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 208 of the aforesaid amended Recycling Ordinance, the fee for the annual permit for haulers to collect recyclable materials in the Borough of Gettysburg shall be set from time to time by resolution of the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg; and


**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg desires to adopt a resolution establishing the fee for the annual permit pertaining to the Recycling Ordinance.

**WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg does hereby adopt the following fee for the annual permit pertaining to its Recycling Ordinance:


1. The annual permit fee for haulers to collect recyclable materials in the Borough of Gettysburg pursuant to its Recycling Ordinance shall be Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars to be paid to the Borough at the time the application is submitted or prior to the issuance of a renewal thereof.
2. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
3. The provisions of this Resolution may be amended according to law by a resolution duly adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg and approved by the Mayor of the Borough of Gettysburg.


