

RESOLUTION NO. 100912-2

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg adopted, enacted and ordained its Code Enforcement Appeals Board Ordinance on March 8, 2010; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3.A.1. of the aforesaid Code Enforcement Appeals Board Ordinance, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg shall appoint by resolution five (5) resident property owners of the Borough as members of the Code Enforcement Appeals Board with terms fixed so that the term of office of one (1) member shall expire each year; and

WHEREAS, Stephen Snyder was appointed to serve as a member of the Code Enforcement Appeals Board by the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg for a term which expired on March 15, 2012; and

WHEREAS, due to the expiration of the term of Stephen Snyder as a member of the Code Enforcement Appeals Board without the appointment of a member to replace Stephen Snyder on the Code Enforcement Appeals Board, a vacancy has occurred in the membership of said Appeals Board since March 16, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg desires to appoint Susan Cipperly to the Code Enforcement Appeals Board for the remainder of a five (5) year term which will expire on March 15, 2017.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg hereby appoints Susan Cipperly to serve as a member of its Code Enforcement Appeals Board for a five (5) year term which will expire on March 15, 2017.

This action is taken under and pursuant to the power of the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg to appoint resident property owners of the Borough to serve as members of its Code Enforcement Appeals Board pursuant to Section 3.A.1. of the Code Enforcement Appeals Board Ordinance.

THIS RESOLUTION DULY ADOPTED according to law on this 9th day of October, 2012, at a duly advertised meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg.


