A Resolution of the Borough of Gettysburg supporting the filing of a proposal for funds with the Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED), Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Interfaith Community Program, Inc. (PICPI) is desirous of obtaining funds from the DCED in the amount of \$500,000 for prevention and elimination of blight under Section 4 (c) of the Housing and Redevelopment Assistance Law, as amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough of Gettysburg that blighting influence exists because of a vacant building and the proposed project will prevent further blight and or eliminate the existing influence by the renovation of a vacant building for the establishment of a community arts education center.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the PICPI will assume the provision of the full local share of the project costs.
