

**RESOLUTION NO. 030810-5**

**WHEREAS**, on June 8, 2009, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg enacted and ordained Ordinance No. 1362-09, its Discharge of Firearms Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 6. of the aforesaid Discharge of Firearms Ordinance, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg shall by resolution establish fees for the issuance of permits for all applications pertaining to its Discharge of Firearms Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, by Resolution No. 060809-2, adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg on June 8, 2009, the Borough Council established a fee of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars for permit applications pertaining to the Discharge of Firearms Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, at its regularly scheduled meeting on February 8, 2010, the Borough Council passed a motion to eliminate the fee for permit applications pertaining to the Discharge of Firearms Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg desires to adopt a resolution eliminating the fee for the issuance of permits for all applications pertaining to the Discharge of Firearms Ordinance.


**WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg does hereby eliminate the fee for the issuance of permits for all applications pertaining to its Discharge of Firearms Ordinance and further provides as follows:

1. An application for a single-event permit pertaining to the Discharge of Firearms Ordinance shall be submitted to the Borough and no fee is required for the same. The single-event permit is valid only for the event described in the permit application. Subsequent events shall require a new permit.
2. An application for an annual permit (more than one event throughout the calendar year) pertaining to the Discharge of Firearms Ordinance shall be submitted to the Borough and no fee is required for the same. The annual permit is valid only for the events to be conducted within the calendar year as described in the permit application. Subsequent events shall require a new permit.
3. All other resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.


4. The provisions of this Resolution may be amended according to law by a resolution duly adopted by the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg and approved by the Mayor of the Borough of Gettysburg.
