

RESOLUTION NO. 041122-1

WHEREAS, in order to facilitate the Gettysburg Gateway Connectivity Project, also known as the Baltimore Street Project, the Borough of Gettysburg intends to submit an application to the United States Department of Transportation for construction funding through the Rebuilding American Infrastructure with Sustainability and Equity (RAISE) discretionary grant program (hereinafter referred to as the “RAISE Grant”); and

WHEREAS, in order to effectively utilize and maximize the impact of potential RAISE Grant funds, the Borough has determined that necessary infrastructure and street safety improvements to Lincoln Square and portions of Chambersburg Street, Carlisle Street and York Street should be added to the Baltimore Street 2018 Master Plan for the Gettysburg Gateway Connectivity Project and made a part of the RAISE Grant application submission; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the Borough’s continued financial commitment to the Gettysburg Gateway Connectivity Project, the availability of a portion of American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) Funds as well as Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, Department of Transportation (PennDOT) funds, the Borough is in a position to commit to and meet the matching requirement for non-federal, local funds for the RAISE Grant program.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, does hereby authorize the amendment of the Borough of Gettysburg Baltimore Street 2018 Master Plan for the addition and inclusion of Lincoln Square and portions of Chambersburg Street, Carlisle Street and York Street to the scope of work for the infrastructure and improvement of street safety components of the project;

WHEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, does hereby authorize the finalization and submission of the RAISE Grant Application to the United States Department of Transportation for fiscal year 2022 funding for the Gettysburg Gateway Connectivity Project with a request for \$9,135,340.00 in federal discretionary grant funds.

WHEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, does hereby authorize its commitment of \$451,535.00 as a required match of non-federal, local funds for the Gettysburg Gateway Connectivity Project, in support of its RAISE Grant Application to the United States Department of Transportation.
