

RESOLUTION NO. 101320-1

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF GETTYSBURG, ADAMS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, CONTINUING, EXTENDING AND
RENEWING THE PARKLET AND PEDLET PILOT TESTING
PROGRAM IN AND ALONG CERTAIN STREETS WITHIN THE
BOROUGH OF GETTYSBURG.**

WHEREAS, Chapter 15, Part 1, section 15-105 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Gettysburg provides that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg (hereinafter referred to as the “Borough Council”) may, from time to time by resolution, and for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, implement specific traffic and/or parking regulations, prohibitions and restrictions at designated locations within the Borough of Gettysburg (hereinafter referred to as the “Borough”); and

WHEREAS, the Gettysburg Borough Planning Department (hereinafter referred to as the “Planning Department”) has explored the possibility of creating parklets and pedlets in and along certain streets and within certain areas of the Borough in order to extend outdoor dining and pedestrian areas beyond the confines of existing sidewalks and to offer additional outdoor dining seating and public gathering spaces; and

WHEREAS, based on its findings, the Planning Department has recommended that the Borough Council implement a pilot testing program for parklets and pedlets through agreements with Borough business and property owners relative to creation, maintenance and status of parklets and pedlets within certain areas of the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, due to the continuing global impact of COVID-19 and the resulting actions of federal, state, county and local governments and agencies relative to precautions and restrictions on businesses and individuals, the Borough Council desires to provide additional outdoor dining seating and public gathering spaces and areas to benefit business owners, residents and visitors to the Borough and to facilitate social distancing protocols; and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 071320-1 on July 13, 2020, the Borough Council authorized and ratified the creation and use of parklets and pedlets in and along certain streets and areas of the Borough pursuant to a pilot testing program; and

WHEREAS, due to the continuing impact of COVID-19 and consistent with the provisions of Chapter 15, Part 1, section 15-105 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Gettysburg, the Borough Council desires to continue, extend and renew, for a period of not more than ninety (90) days, the parklet and pedlet pilot testing program.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, does hereby continue, extend and renew the parklet and pedlet pilot testing program originally authorized by action of the Borough Council pursuant to Resolution No. 071320-1 adopted on July 13, 2020, for a period of ninety (90) days.

The continuation, extension and renewal of the parklet and pedlet pilot testing program, as authorized herein, shall terminate on January 11, 2021 unless subsequently extended by the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg.
