

RESOLUTION NO. 101320-2

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF GETTYSBURG, ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, CONTINUING, EXTENDING AND RENEWING THE SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 6, PART 2 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF GETTYSBURG RELATIVE TO THE POSSESSION AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IN DESIGNATED PUBLIC AREAS IN CONNECTION WITH THE PARKING AND PEDLET PILOT TESTING PROGRAM WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF GETTYSBURG.

WHEREAS, due to the continuing global impact of COVID-19 and the resulting actions of federal, state, county and local governments and agencies relative to precautions and restrictions on businesses and individuals, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg (the “Borough Council”) desires to mitigate the significant economic impact of COVID-19 on eating and drinking establishments within the Borough of Gettysburg caused by mandatory closings and openings restricted by limited indoor patron capacity; and

WHEREAS, in furtherance of the desire of the Borough Council to mitigate the economic impact of COVID-19 on eating and drinking establishments within the Borough of Gettysburg, and in connection with the temporary parklet and pedlet pilot program for the conversion of various public parking spaces into outdoor dining seating and public gathering spaces and areas, businesses providing food and beverage services to the public will have an opportunity to provide extended outside seating and dining areas for use by their patrons; and

WHEREAS, by adoption of Resolution No. 071320-2 on July 13, 2020, the Borough Council authorized the temporary suspension of the prohibitions of Chapter 6, Part 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Gettysburg relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages only in certain parklet and pedlet public areas of the Borough in connection with the use of such parklets and pedlets pursuant to the implementation of the pilot testing program within the Borough of Gettysburg.

WHEREAS, due to the continuing impact of COVID-19, and consistent with the continuation, extension and renewal of the Borough’s parklet and pedlet pilot testing program, the Borough Council desires to continue, extend and renew the temporary suspension of the prohibitions of Chapter 6, Part 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Gettysburg relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in connection with the use of parklet and pedlet public areas of the Borough.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, does hereby continue, extend and renew the suspension of the prohibitions of Chapter 6, Part 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the Borough of Gettysburg relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in connection with the use of parklet and pedlet public areas of the Borough, originally authorized by action of the Borough Council pursuant to Resolution No. 071320-2 adopted on July 13, 2020.

WHEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that consistent with the continuation, extension and renewal of the suspension of prohibitions relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in certain public areas of the Borough, eating and drinking establishments, properly licensed by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board, may sell, in non-breakable containers, alcoholic beverages for consumption only in designated parklet and pedlet areas authorized pursuant to the Borough's pilot testing program. By the adoption of Resolution No. 101320-1, the Borough Council has continued, extended and renewed the Borough's parklet and pedlet pilot testing program for a period of ninety (90) days until January 11, 2021.


This continuation, extension and renewal of the suspension of the prohibitions relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in certain public areas shall not supersede any regulations of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board or the ordinances or any other applicable laws or regulations of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania or of the Borough of Gettysburg.

This continuation, extension and renewal of the suspension of the prohibitions relative to the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages in certain public areas, as set forth herein, shall expire upon the termination of the Borough's parklet and pedlet pilot testing program and any extensions thereof.
