

RESOLUTION NO. 101320-4

WHEREAS, Brian D. Eastman was duly elected in the municipal election held in November 2017 and he then subsequently qualified as Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg for a four (4) year term of office which term commenced on the first Monday of January 2018 and which term will expire on the first Monday of January 2022; and

WHEREAS, Brian D. Eastman tendered his resignation as Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg, effective September 15, 2020, due to his subsequent termination of residency from the Borough of Gettysburg in early October 2020, which resignation was accepted by a majority vote of a quorum of the Borough Council at a duly advertised monthly general business meeting of the Borough Council held on September 14, 2020; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the termination of residency from the Borough of Gettysburg of Brian D. Eastman and his resignation as Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg, a vacancy in such elective office has occurred as of September 15, 2020, the effective date of Mr. Eastman's resignation; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the provisions of the Borough Code at 8 Pa. C.S.A. §901, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg shall fill the vacancy in the elective office of tax collector within thirty (30) days of such vacancy by appointing an eligible registered elector of the Borough of Gettysburg to hold such office for the remainder of the term of office which will expire on the first Monday in January of 2022. No person shall be eligible for appointment to fill this vacancy in elective office as Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg unless she or he has resided within the Borough of Gettysburg continuously for at least one (1) year immediately prior to her or his appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg desires to appoint an eligible, registered elector of the Borough of Gettysburg to fill the vacancy in the office of Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg due to the termination of residency from the Borough of Gettysburg of Brian D. Eastman and his resignation from that elective office. The person appointed to fill the aforesaid vacancy shall hold such office from the date of this resolution, subject to her or his taking the required oath of office and providing the required affidavit relative to her or his eligibility to hold such office, until the first Monday in January 2022, which is the date of the expiration of the term of office of Brian D. Eastman as Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg.

WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, hereby appoints Lisa A. Angstadt as Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg to fill the vacancy in the elective office of Borough tax collector occurring by the resignation of the termination of residency from

the Borough of Gettysburg of Brian D. Eastman and his resignation from that elective office, until the first Monday in January 2022, which is the date of the expiration of the term of office of Brian D. Eastman as Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg.


This appointment to the office Tax Collector of the Borough of Gettysburg is conditioned upon the receipt by the Borough of Gettysburg of a signed affidavit executed and delivered to the Borough Secretary by the aforesaid appointee stating and affirming under oath that: 1) she is a registered elector of the Borough of Gettysburg; 2) that she resides within the Borough of Gettysburg; and 3) that she has resided in the Borough of Gettysburg continuously for at least one (1) year prior to her appointment.

This action is taken under and pursuant to the power of a borough council to appoint a registered elector of the borough to fill a vacancy in the elective borough office of tax collector as authorized pursuant to the Borough Code at 8 Pa. C.S.A. §901.
