**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE
BOROUGH OF GETTYSBURG, ADAMS COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF A 2016 FORD
POLICE INTERCEPTOR SUV TO LIBERTY TOWNSHIP,
ADAMS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, PURSUANT TO SECTION
1201.2 AND SECTION 1201.3 OF THE BOROUGH CODE.**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Gettysburg owns a 2016 Ford Police Interceptor SUV with an estimated fair market value of six thousand five hundred (\$6,500.00) dollars, as provided to the Borough by its motor fleet manager, Enterprise Fleet Management; and

WHEREAS, consistent with section 1201.2(a) of the Borough Code (8 Pa C.S.A. §1201.2(a)), no borough personal property may be disposed of, by sale or otherwise, except upon the approval of borough council by resolution; and

WHEREAS, consistent with section 1201.3(a)(1) of the Borough Code (8 Pa C.S.A. §1201.3(a)(1)), the advertisement for bids or sale at public auction shall not be required for the sale of borough personal property to a county, city, borough, town, township, institution district, school district, volunteer fire company, volunteer ambulance service or volunteer rescue squad located within the borough; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Gettysburg desires to sell the 2016 Ford Police Interceptor SUV, for its estimated fair market value, to Liberty Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, Liberty Township has agreed to purchase the 2016 Ford Police Interceptor SUV for the sum of six thousand five hundred (\$6,500.00) dollars.


WHEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania, does hereby authorize the sale of the 2016 Ford Police Interceptor SUV (VIN # 1FM5K8AR2GGC72672) to Liberty Township, Adams County, Pennsylvania, for its estimated fair market value of six thousand five hundred (\$6,500.00) dollars.

This action is taken under and pursuant to the power of the Borough of Gettysburg to sell Borough personal property upon approval of the Borough Council by resolution pursuant to section 1201.2(a) of the Borough Code and to sell such personal property to Liberty Township without the advertisement for bids or the sale of such Borough personal property at public auction to the highest bidder, consistent with section 1201.3(a) of the Borough Code.

THIS RESOLUTION DULY ADOPTED according to law on this 9th day of November, 2020, at a duly advertised monthly general business meeting of the Borough Council of the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Pennsylvania.
